"The Antichrist" 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12

After the rapture of the church, the world's last dictator shall arise. He is Satan's man, the false Christ, the antichrist, the rival attempting to deny and defeat the true Christ—our wonderful Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He is the embodiment of all that is evil, yet he appears at first to be the opposite—a man of peace and unity. He takes leadership over the entire world and at the mid-point of the tribulation period he declares himself to be god and demands absolute worship.
