## SERMON OUTLINE & NOTES

### “Joy In the Presence of the Lord” Philippians 4:4-7

In life, always opt for joy over happiness. They are totally different. Happiness has in its name its definition—happenings. Happiness depends on happenings. Success, achievements, awards, recognition or victories can result in great happiness. But in happiness you can go from the highest heights to the throes of despair in minutes.

Job was God’s choice servant. He had no equal in his love, walk and trust in the Lord. In one day he lost his holdings, children and possessions. He tore his robe, shaved his head and fell on his face in sadness and worship. He wasn’t a man dependent on happenings. He rested in the joy of the Lord! (Job 1:21). Always:

#### I. Resolve to choose joy over happiness

Early on Tuesday morning, I was walking in Yellow Creek Park...Abused, lied to, cheated on, not loved, abandoned, homeless, fatherless, left in the dirt, feeling attacked, weight of the world, brother’s death, grandpa’s suicide, grandma’s death...

#### II. Joy comes from residing in the presence of the Lord (Psalm 16:11, Nehemiah 8:10)

#### III. Joy comes from relying on the promises of God (Philippians 1:6)

#### IV. Joy comes from resting in the providential hands of God
