## SERMON OUTLINE & NOTES

### “The Lord’s Supper” 1 Corinthians 11:23-32

Today we have the wonderful privilege and blessing of participating in the ordinance (an order, a command) of the Lord’s Supper. As long as the church remains in this world we are to observe the Lord’s Supper.

The Scriptures do not identify how often we are to observe this memorial meal. The frequency will be determined by your view concerning the Lord’s Supper.

If you believe in “transubstantiation” (that the elements actually become the body and blood of Jesus) and by ingesting Jesus you actually receive the saving grace of God, then you will observe the Supper every time you gather.

If your belief is “consubstantiation” (Jesus’ presence is in the elements), who would not desire to have this special encounter with Jesus every Lord’s Day?

The Scriptures declare the Lord’s Supper is a “memorial” to the saving work of Jesus accomplished through His death, burial and resurrection. “This do in remembrance of Me.” The Lord’s Supper pictures for us Jesus’ passion to redeem us and His promise to return for us! The Lord’s Supper is a time of remembrance:

- I. We are to look back and remember His passion.  
 (Corinthians 15:1-4; I Corinthians 6:20, 7:23)\_
- II. We are to look inward and remember His presence.  
 (1 Corinthians 6:19; Ephesians 4:30)
- III. We are to look forward and remember His purpose.  
 (Hebrews 2:9; II Peter 3:9; Mark 16:15)
- IV. We are to look around and remember His power.  
 (Ephesians 2:12-13, 19-22)
- V. We are to look upward and remember His person.  
 (Acts 1:11; Revelation 1:7)

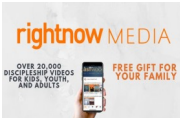
