MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

PRINCIPLES FOR VICTORIOUS LIVING Hebrews 12:1-3

We have been examining principles, if practiced, that would lead to a blessed, winning Christian life in 2024 and for the rest of our earthly lives. We have challenged ourselves to "follow the pattern exhibited by the faithful" in Hebrews eleven. Principle two "challenged us to discard excess weight and avoid sins that entangle and ensnare us."

Principle three commands us to "refuse to quit." Life for the believer is <u>always</u> tough because we are like salmon fighting upstream to live and reflect the life of Jesus Christ. Some seasons even in a Christians life are virtually unbearable, but it is then that we must not give up.

The will to fight and win by refusing to quit is expressed in the poem "Don't Quit" by Edgar A Guest:

When things go wrong, as they sometimes will, When the road you're trudging seems all up hill, When funds are low, but the debts are high, And you want to smile, but you have to sigh, When care is pressing you down a bit—Rest if you must, but don't you quit.

Life is strange with its twists and turns,
As everyone of us sometimes learns,
And many failures turn about,
When we might have won had we stuck it out;
Don't give up though the pace seems slow—
You may succeed with another blow.

Success is failure turned inside out—
The silver tint of clouds of doubt,
You can never tell how close you are,
It may be near when it seems so far;
So stick to the fight when you're hardest hit—
It's when things seem worst, that you must not quit.
