MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

"The Sufferings of The Savior" Isaiah 52:13-53:12

We have spent the past three weeks examining the suffering of the saints. We have seen how in the Father's love and grace, all Christian suffering is meaningful, merciful, momentary and manageable.

Today, we will examine the sufferings of the Savior on our behalf. The Bible declares His suffering was a substitutionary sacrifice, a saving sacrifice and a sufficient sacrifice.

Isaiah informs us that the suffering of Jesus has no parallel in time or eternity. The love that motivated this suffering was other-worldly (I John 3:1). The commitment that made this sacrifice was one-of-a-kind (Hebrews 9:26b). The conclusion delivered by His sacrifice is - every person is redeemable (I John 1:7c).

Isaiah informs us that the sacrifice of Jesus Christ for you and me made Him no longer recognizable as a human being (Isaiah 52:14). As we examine the sufferings of Jesus, I want us to see His physical, emotional and spiritual sufferings.
