MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

"When We All Get To Heaven" Hebrews 12:18-29

The writer of Hebrews contrasts the coming of Israel to Mount Sinai with the arrival of the saints in heaven. When Israel became a covenant people at Sinai there was great fear attached to the event. Moses even said, "I am exceedingly afraid and trembling."

The scenery was terrifying, not comforting (Exodus 19:12-13, 16-19). The presence of God was so intense the mountain was smoking, lightening was flashing, thunder rolled and the mountain was shaking in response to the holy presence of the Lord. The sound of the trumpet petrified the people while God was shielded in thick darkness (Exodus 19:9-11).

The God revealed on Sinai was not approachable (Exodus 19:20-24). A parameter was set around the mountain. Any person or animal who touched the mountain was to be killed. Almighty God was concealed in majesty and mystery.

Arriving at Mount Zion, the city of the Living God, is a totally different event. Heaven will be warm and welcoming. Faith will be realized and rewarded. Shouts of joy shall abound and celebration will ensue (Revelation 4 and 5).
