MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

**“Keys To Personal Revival In The Lord”
 Hebrews 32-39**

The evidence from Scripture is the Lord longs to send revival to His people. There can never be mass revival without individual revival in individual hearts!

While we pray for national revival, we must aspire to personal revival so our lives can become a catalyst to renewal in our land. Psalm 85:6 says, “Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you.” Personal revival leads to celebration and rejoicing in our Lord’s presence. Acts 3:19 declares, “Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, that seasons of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord.” Revival leads to fresh starts, new walks and returned vigor in the Lord.

The apostle Paul tells Timothy and us how to have revival in our lives (II Timothy 1:6). Revival is a resuscitation and restoration of our former joy, peace, power, fellowship and love for our Lord (Psalm 85:8, 10, 11).

The writer of Hebrews calls us to “recall” - to remember, to carefully think back, to reconstruct the picture in our minds, to relive a vital event in the past and bring it powerfully into our present. The power of memory is an incredible gift. It was a memory that moved David from brokenness to renewal (Psalms 32 & 51). It was a memory that moved Peter from denial to proclamation. It was a memory that could have saved the Ephesian Church (Revelation 2:5).

Our own memories can bring us to experience personal, powerful revival with our Lord.

- III. Remember your determination (Hebrews 10:35-36)
- IV. Remember your evaluation (Hebrews 10:37-39; Ecclesiastes 12:13-14)
