Mother's Day: The Ideal Mother Luke 1:26-38

With the selection of the 267th pope on Thursday, the air-waves have been filled with non-Biblical, erroneous doctrine (teaching). Peter was not the first pope. He gives testimony to who he is (1 Peter 2:4-10). Peter never was and never will be the foundation of the church (Matthew 16:15-18; 1 Corinthians 3:9-15; Ephesians 1:19-23; Ephesians 2:19-22). Peter does not have the keys to get you to heaven or condemn you to hell (Revelation 1:16-18).

Mary met all the Biblical requirements for the mother of the Messiah, Jesus Christ. She is from the tribe of Judah (Genesis 49:8-10; Luke 3:33). Mary is from the House of David through Nathan (Luke 3:31). Mary is a virgin at the conception of Jesus Christ by the power and presence of the Holy Spirit (Isaiah 7:14; Luke 1:27, 34).

Mary is not the perpetual virgin (2 Council of Constantinople 553). Mary had a minimum of 7 children (Mark 6:2-3). Mary did not have an immaculate conception (April 7, 1623—Pope Gregory XV). She is not <u>equal</u> to or <u>above</u> Jesus Christ!

As we examine the Scriptures, we will establish the sterling character of an ideal mother. We will see what the Father wants from mothers.
