MESSAGE FROM GOD'S WORD

"The Revelation of Jesus Christ: Jesus Glorious Return" Revelation 19:11-21

The Second coming (the Revelation) is clearly distinguished from the Rapture of the church. The Rapture happens seven years before the Revelation. At the rapture Jesus Christ comes into the air for His saints (John 14:1-3; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-19; 1 Corinthians 15:51-52). At the second coming He comes with His saints. At the rapture Jesus meets His saints in the air (1 Thessalonians 4:17) and takes us to heaven (John 14:2-3). At His second coming, He descends with them from heaven to the earth (Zachariah 14:4).

They are not the same event. In the rapture there is no hint of judgement, but judgement plays a prominent role in the second coming (Revelation 19:11, 15, 17-21).

The rapture occurs in Revelation 4:1-2. John is taken up to heaven. The return happens in Revelation 19:11 when Jesus exits heaven and comes to earth.

There are four undeniable pictures seen in the Revelation:

- I. The Return of the Conqueror-Revelation 19:11-13
- II. The Regiments with the Conqueror-Revelation 19:14 (The armies in heaven)


