MESSAGE FROM GOD’S WORD

The Coming Kingdom
Revelation 20:1-10

The millennial Kingdom (the thousand year reign of Jesus) is called by many names in Scripture. Jesus called it “the regeneration” (Matthew 19:28). Acts 3:19 describes the Kingdom age as “times of refreshing.” Acts 3:21 calls it “the period of restoration of all things.” The Bible’s teaching of the Kingdom is not confined to the New Testament. One in every twenty-five verses in the Old Testament refers to the kingdom ruled over by Jesus. The coming kingdom is the goal toward which all of redemptive history progresses.

Last time we examined the revelation of Jesus Christ concluding the tribulation period. After His return, He will establish a literal kingdom on earth which will last for a thousand years.

Revelation 20:1-10 caps off all the Biblical revelation of the millennium in four essential truths.

I. The Removal of Satan (Revelation 20:1-3)

II. The reign of the Saints (Revelation 20:4-6)

III. The return of Satan (Revelation 20:7)

IV. The revolt of society (Revelation 20:8-10)
