SERMON OUT LINE & NOTES

"It Is Your Choice" Revelation 22:12-21

Life has been defined as the sum total of all our choices. Choices produce attitudes. Attitudes produce actions. Actions produce character and at some point character becomes permanent (Revelation 22:11).

So much of our lives we have no choice. We had no choice in our birth. We had no choice in our color. We had no choice in our sex. But in the midst of all this choicelessness, we do choose how we shall live!

Billy Graham began his sermon with a question. "Where will you be in one hundred years?" Where we will be in one hundred years will be determined by our choices today!

- I. Life's ultimate choice is a Necessary Choice
 - A. This choice is sounded throughout Scripture (Deuteronomy 30:19; Joshua 24:14-15; I Kings 18:21; Revelation 22:17)
 - B. Choose is an imperative—form of a command that cannot de denied or avoided—To every man there opens...
 - C. Jesus demands a choice (Matthew 6:24; Matthew 12:30)
- II. Life's Ultimate choice is a Personal Choice
 - A. You—a personal choice for your own life
 - B. Each person must decide for himself (Ezekiel 18:2-4)
 - C. Who is responsible for our lives (church, community, home, the individual) (Mr. Bennett-86 years old)
- III. Life's Ultimate choice is an Urgent Choice (Hebrews 3:7-8a; Proverbs 27:1; Proverbs 29:1; 2 Corinthians 6:2)
 - A. God's Word—Today
 - B. Satan's Word-Tomorrow
- IV. Life's Ultimate Choice is a Logical Choice
 - A. No one ever cared for you like Jesus...
 - B. There is a hell to shun and a heaven to embrace


