SERMON OUT LINE & NOTES

“The Grace Of God”
Revelation 22:21

The Bible closes with a beautiful benediction. “The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all.” This precious word (Charis) is used 120 plus times in the New Testament. The closest word for grace in the Old Testament is “Hesed.” Hesed speaks of God’s faithful, loyal, steadfast love. It is illustrated in 2 Samuel 9:1,3. David searches for anyone left from the house of Saul that he could show the kindness, kindness of God for Jonathan’s sake. David and Jonathan made a covenant of love.

Grace is the word favor, benefit, blessing, gift, gracious, graciousness. Grace is God’s unmerited favor. Even greater, it is God’s unmeritable favor. It has nothing to do with sinful, undeserving, hell-bound, helpless sinners. It has only to do with the incredible, unmatched, never earned love of a holy, merciful, forgiving God!

Grace has been defined as: God’s Riches At Christ’s Expense! 2 Corinthians 8:9; 2 Corinthians 9:15.
