MESSAGE FROM GOD'S WORD

"Running To Win" Philippians 3:7-14

In Paul's writings, he often uses illustrations from the world around him to communicate the truths concerning the Christian life. He uses the "armed forces" - "put on the whole armer of God." He uses "architecture" - "You are the temple of God." He uses "agriculture" - "You are God's cultivated field," and "whatever a man sows that shall he also reap." He also uses "athletics" - "in a race all run but only one wins the prize, so run that you may obtain (win)."

In the passage we are examining today, Paul compares the Christian life to a foot race. In the race to become the greatest Christian we can be, we must forget, focus and finish. May we run with endurance the race set before us.

In this Scripture, Paul sees himself as an <u>accountant</u> who traded everything in his <u>past</u> to embrace Jesus Christ, the true value in life. In his <u>future</u> he views himself as an <u>alien</u> - "our citizenship is in heaven." Therefore, he lived not for this world but for the world which is coming. In the <u>present</u>, he is the <u>athlete</u> whose goal is to finish his purpose and please his Master, Jesus Christ!
