MESSAGE FROM GOD'S WORD

"Christian Contentment" Philippians 4:10-20

In our guest for contentment (Containment) we have discovered that Christ's-Sufficiency is anchored in a clear past, a confident present and a certain future. We found the source of our contentment is the all-sufficiency of our relationship with Our Savior, our reaction to the school of hard knocks and our reliance and remembrance of the power of God.

Today, we will examine the substance from which containment (the inner resources) for the life of contentment. This passage before us provides four spiritual resources to aid the life of contentment.


