MESSAGE FROM GOD’S WORD

“Down With Worry, Up With Faith”
Matthew 6:25-34

It has been said—“The average person is crucifying him-
self between two thieves: the regrets of yesterday and the
worries of tomorrow.” They are both outside your control! The
past can only be covered by the mercy, grace and forgiveness of
the Lord Jesus Christ (I John 1:9; Hebrews 8:12; Acts 3:19). And
the future is held by His precious, powerful, providing and
pierced hands (Proverbs 27:1; James 4:13-16; Psalm 31:15).

The Lord Jesus, The Lord of Life, The Sovereign of
Eternity tells us worry is useless. “Which of you by worrying can
add one cubit to his stature?” You future is not controlled by
chance, but by the changeless, unconquerable Christ!

According to the National Bureau of Standards, a dense
fog covering seven city blocks to a depth of one hundred feet is
composed of less than one eight- ounce glass of water. This fog
that blinds, debilitates and endangers life is comparable to just t
a small fraction of our lives and not worthy of the time and
energy we invest in them.

- I. Don’t Worry!
 - A. Worry is sinful
 - 1. Worry is ineffective for man
 - 2. Worry is insulting to a loving, heavenly Father
 - 3. Worry is insufficient for life
 - B. Worry is solved!
 - 1. Faith—trusting God to meet our needs (6:30)
 - 2. Father—knowing He cares for His children (6:32)
 - 3. First—putting the will of God as our priority (6.33)
- II. Build Faith!
 - A. Add On—2 Peter 1:5-9
 - B. Add Up—Philippians 4:1-7
 - 1. Record—name is in the Lambs Book of Life (4:3)
 - 2. Rejoice—the Lord is always near (4:4-5)
 - 3. Requests—perception, prayer, peace (4:6-7)
 - 4. Remember—everything works together for good (Romans 8:28)

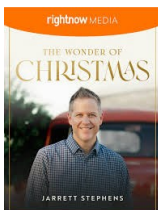

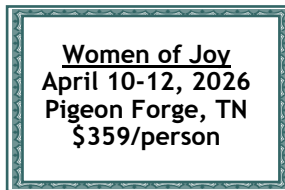
Love Came Down Outreach Ministry
