MESSAGE FROM GOD’S WORD

“2026: A Year of Peace ”

John 14:25-27, 16:33

Last time we discovered that peace is a Gracious gift from Almighty God. Peace is established by faith— “Therefore, being justified by faith we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ” (Romans 5:1). Peace continues and grows through on-going fellowship in and with the powerful Holy Spirit. “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus” (Philippians 4:6-7). Peace extends and expands through the recognition and relationship of family. And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly” (Romans 16:20).

Today we want to think of peace as a guarantee from God, who loves us with an everlasting love “and if God be for us who can stand against us, He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?” (Romans 8:31B-32).

- I. Peace is a Guarantee from God (Isaiah 26:3-4)
 - A. Perfect Peace- An ongoing experience of security and calm
 1. Kept by God
 2. Clear focus on God
 3. Certain trust in God’s ability
 - B. Perfect Love (I John 4:17-19)
 1. Precious confidence in the face of judgment
 2. Banishes fear (faith and fear do not co-exist)
 3. Fear displaces faith
 4. Faith chases away fear
 - C. Powerful Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13-14, 4:30; II Corinthians 5:4-8)
 - D. Precious Promises (John 10:24-30; I John 5:10-13)
