## MESSAGE FROM GOD'S WORD

### “2026: A Year of Peace”

John 14:25-27, 16:33

The Bible is filled with promises that will bring peace in the midst of struggles, worries, fear and frustration. There are 430 verses in the Bible containing the word “Peace” (Psalm 4:8).

Our heavenly Father promises us peace “that surpasses all understanding.” Isaiah 41:10 says, “Fear not ....” King David sometimes considered flight as his rescue from fear and troubles (Psalm 55:4-7). But in the end he always returned to the true answer, faith (Psalm 56:3). This verse is a corrective after the lion of fear has pounced upon you. But I have a better verse for you. Isaiah 12:2 is a preventive from fear.

We have seen that peace is a “Gift” from God and a “Guarantee” from God. Today, we will see how peace is the means of guarding His children in love.

  - C. To provide through prayer the protection (II Kings 6:18-20)
  - D. For the weapons of our welfare are mighty through God (II Corinthians 10:4-5)
