MESSAGE FROM GOD'S WORD

“Faithfully Facing the Fiery Trials”

2 Peter 1:1-15

The Apostle Peter has done his best to prepare these saints for the expanding, engulfing fiery trial which is advancing against them (1 Peter 4:12-14). The intensity will continue to grow until all-out-war is waged against the church. Nero wants to stamp out Christianity. He wants to wash the truth of Jesus Christ from the earth through the blood of those who love Jesus.

In short fashion, multiplied millions of saints will be brutally murdered for the faith. Christian women will be used as living torches to light Nero’s gardens at night. Christian men will be used in sporting events. The apostle Paul will be beheaded. Peter will be crucified head down.

How do we face the fiery trials in life...?

Peter tells us what to do. We must remember, recall, recount, the important processes of the Christian life. The word means to carefully think back, to reconstruct the picture in our minds, to relive a vital event in the past and bring it powerfully into the present!

The power of memory is an incredible gift! It was memory that moved the prodigal... It was memory that moved King David... It was memory that moved Peter... And, memory will move us from mediocrity to magnificence.

I. Remember your salvation (2 Peter 1:19; 2 Timothy 1:12; 1 Peter 3:15)

II. Remember your destination (1 Peter 5:10-11; Colossians 3:1-4; Romans 8:38-39)

III. Remember your determination (Luke 9:22, 51; Acts 20:22-25; Acts 21:13; 2 Corinthians 5:9)

IV. Remember your evaluation (2 Corinthians 5:10; 2 Timothy 4:6-8; Jude 1:24-25)
