## MESSAGE FROM GOD’S WORD

### “When I See The Cross”

Galatians 3:1

The cross of Jesus is the focal point of all of human history! The cross of Jesus is pictured throughout Scripture. When Adam and Eve sinned, God killed the animals and made a covering for Adam and Eve (Genesis 3:21).

In the Passover Lamb of Exodus 12, Jesus is portrayed as the perfect, sinless Lamb of God who will ultimately take away the sin of the entire world (1 Corinthians 5:7) “For Christ, our Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed for us.”

The servant in the wilderness lifted upon a pole (Numbers 21:8) is a picture of Jesus and His cross (John 3:14-15).

Isaiah, 750 years before the birth, declared Jesus as the perfect Lamb!

David, one thousand years before His incarnation, sat at the foot of the cross and was an eyewitness account of His passion.

Here, the Galatians traveled back to Calvary spiritually and witnessed His crucifixion. Isaac Watts wrote in 1707 “When I Survey The Wonderous Cross.”


What should we see when we see the cross?
