MESSAGE FROM GOD’S WORD

“The First Lord’s Supper”

Luke 22:10-34

The yearly Passover was to be a celebration of remembrance, reflection, resolve, rejoicing and renewal (Exodus 6:6-8). The ceremony was built around four cups. First, the cup of sanctification, “I will bring you out.” Second, the cup of deliverance, “I will rescue you from bondage.” Third, the cup of redemption, “I will redeem you with an outstretched arm.” Fourth, the cup of praise, “I will take you as My people.”

The Lord’s Supper should be a time of praise, thanksgiving, dedication, renewal and fresh commitment. The first Lord’s Supper had several problems attached to it. Lost Judas, who had sold Jesus for thirty pieces of silver is present at the table—treachery! James and John who sought to be numbers one and two in Jesus’ Kingdom are there—jealousy! Peter, who promised a love and loyalty above the others is present—hypocrisy!

We cannot assume when we come today we are sold out, surrendered, dedicated to Jesus first and all-in for Him. We may need to do some major cleaning and confession before we observe this Supper.

I. He died for us and are we truly willing to die for Him?
2 Corinthians 5:14-15; Revelation 2:10; Acts 7:54-60;
Acts 20:24

This is truly the commitment we made!

II. He left it all to die for us what have we sacrificed to live for Him? 2 Corinthians 8:9; 1 Peter 2:24

III. He followed the Father’s will completely. How closely have we followed our Father’s will? Hebrew 10:7
Does He need to wash us today?
Does He need to scold our selfishness?
Does He need to break our defiance of His plan and will?
Will a man rob God…?
