**MESSAGE FROM GOD’S WORD**

**“The Seven Characteristics Of A Unified Church”**

Ephesians 4:1-6

In Paul’s writings he does us a great favor. He begins with doctrine, then proceeds with discipline (discipleship). He identifies who we are in Christ and then tells us what we should be since we are in Christ Jesus.

In Ephesians 1-3 Paul declares our wealth in Christ (Ephesians 1:3). Six times he declares we have been lifted by Jesus Christ “into heavenly places.” In chapters 4-6 he informs us of what our walk should be as we measure up to the goodness, grace and glory of the Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, in Christ Jesus we are:

- I. One Body
  - A. Jesus Christ—The One Head (Ephesians 2:19-22; Colossians 1:12-18)
  - B. We—the individual but unified members of His Body (1 Corinthians 12:21-27; Ephesians 4:11-13)
- II. One Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:11-13; Acts 11:12-18)
- III. One Hope (1 Peter 5:10-11; Titus 1:2; Titus 2:11-14)
- IV. One Lord (Philippians 2:5-11) “No Lord But Christ”
- V. One Faith (Jude 1:3; 2 Peter 1:16-21)
- VI. One Baptism (1 Corinthians 12:13; Romans 6:3-4)
- VII. One God—Transcendent, yet Immanent
