**MESSAGE FROM GOD'S WORD**

**“A Father’s Life”**

**Psalm 12:8**

Being a father is much more than a physical reality. A father is a spiritual and moral responsibility. Fatherlessness is destroying the American home. Twenty million American children live in a home where no father is present. Eighty-percent of single-parent homes are led by single mothers. Children from single-parent families are twice as likely to suffer from mental health and behavioral problems.

Seventy percent of youth in state operated facilities are from single-parent homes. From the sixty plus school shootings we have had in America, eighty two percent of the shooters grew up in an unstable family environment (without both biological parents). As the father goes, so goes the family, and as the family goes, so goes the nation.
