## MESSAGE FROM GOD’S WORD

### Keys To Spiritual Maturity

1 Peter 5:5-7

Peter is coming to the end of his life. The Lord not only told him when he would die (“Shortly”—2 Peter 1:13-14), but also how he would die. (John 21:17-19)

As long as Peter had life, his desire was to “stir up” the people of God. Paul wrote to Timothy to “Stir up” Timothy. The words mean “to fan to an open flame”, “to burn at white heat.” The Lord wants up to be on fire for Him and to continue in faithfulness.

Peter gives us three principles to lead us on to maturity, to a continuation of spiritual growth.

- I. We must have constant Submission to the Word and Will of God. (1 Peter 5:5)
    - A. The Greek word is hupotassō—to line up under-military term- “follow the leader.”
    - B. Spiritual maturity can only be achieved by obeying God.
    - C. There is Biblical proof submission is essential.
      1. King Saul (1 Samuel 15:1-3, 7-9, 10-11, 13-14, 22-23)
      2. Samson—a Nazarite from birth (separated). (Judges 13-Birth)
        - a. Not to go near a corpse (Numbers 6:6-7)
        - b. No strong drink (Numbers 6:3-4)
        - c. No cutting of the hair (Numbers 6:5)
  - Note: Sin blinds, sin binds, sin grinds.
  3. Praise God! There is a way back—David and Peter.
- II. We must live life in Humility. (lowly mindedness) (1 Peter 5:6)
  - A. You put on humility.
  - B. You follow the example of Jesus. (Matthew 16:24-27)
- III. We must trust the Father’s Power totally. (1 Peter 5:7)
