“Hope For A Nation”

2 Chronicles 7:12-16; Revelation 2:1-5

The Bible is filled with blessings upon any nation, any people or any person who will walk in obedience and fellowship with the Lord. (Psalm 33:11-13; Genesis 12:1-3). We are commanded by God not to be an offense to Jews, Gentiles, or the church of God (1 Corinthians 10:32).

The problem is God also pronounces judgments, curses upon nations who turn away from and forget the Lord, the One True God! 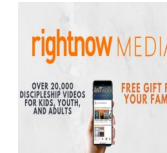
